God works in a variety of ways. We're not just talking about extraordinary miracles. We're also talking about God's daily work to mold your character, to influence you and to help you.



Activitiy: "Experience It"

Instructions:

Experiences give us opportunity to shape the type of character we want to develop. They are tools we can use to develop into the type of person we want to be. God allows us to experience all kinds of different events in order to give us exactly the opportunities we need to become trustworthy, kind, generous, loving and more like Jesus.

Take a few minutes to think about an experience you've had that has had a significant effect on you. What was your response to the experience and how has it helped you shape your life?

Groups: Have each participant write down a brief reference to their experience on a piece of paper (e.g. "traveled to Cuba", "my father wrote me a special letter", "tamed a wild cat", etc.). Place all pieces of paper in a bucket. Randomly draw one out and read it out loud. Have participants guess to see if they know who experienced it. Then have the person who really experienced it reveal themselves and share more of the story if they like.
